Class 2 had a fantastic Forest School afternoon doing their bare foot walk around the school grounds and planning their gardening/planting schedule for the winter months.

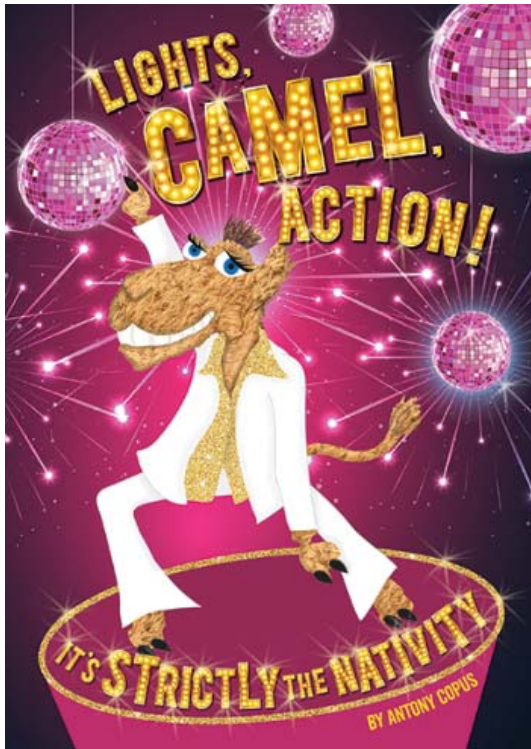
We welcomed back Reverend Doug this week for his first Assembly of the year - the children really engage with Doug and we are always thrilled to have him with us.
