STAFF RAMBLE FOR CHILDREN IN NEED

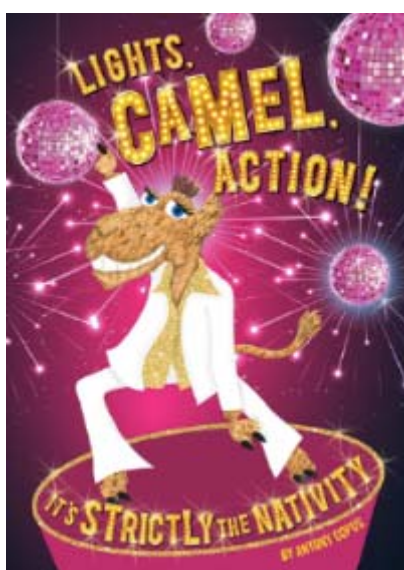
A staff team from All Saints will be taking part in their own Countryfile Ramble for Children in Need.
